


Checking FAFSA Parent Information Status


- Go to <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> select returning user to log in with your FSA ID to Access your FAFSA
- Select “I am a student and want to access the FAFSA form.”
- Click on “2022-23” and select “Make Corrections to FAFSA form”


